6 and 7-year-old boys play ROOKIE: Basic skills taught, coach

pitch, emphasis on learning and teamwork. RIF ball.

• Some 7, 8 and 9-year-old boys play MINOR A: Basic skills taught, coach/kid pitch emphasis on learning and teamwork.

• Some 8, 9, 10 and some 11-year-old boys play MINOR AA:

Players pitch and assigned according to draft and skill level.

• Some 10, 11, and 12-year-old boys play MAJORS: Players assigned according to draft and skill level.

• INTERMEDIATE DIVISION: 11-13-yr-olds: 50ft mound/70ft bases, District, League, can play both Major, PONY or 50/70 only. See pg. 4. • 13 and 14-year-old boys play TRI-T PONY/LL Jr Lg.

• 15 through 18-year-old boys play TRI-T COLT.

• Some 8, 9 and 10-year-old girls play MINOR: Basic skills taught, players pitch and assigned by draft and skill level.

• Some 10,11 and 12-year-old girls play MAJORS: Players assigned by draft. Play in surrounding communities.

• 13 and 14-year-old girls play TRI-T PONY/LL Jr. Lg.: Play in surrounding communities & the Fields of Dreams.

League Age Determination:

The BCB age is the age of your child as of **4/30/17 or 08/31/17** for **BOYS** and **DECEMBER 31, 2016** for **GIRLS**. Due to Little League rules and insurance issues BCB will strictly observe the age rules. All players must reside in the **BOARDMAN LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT OR ATTEND A SCHOOL IN BOARDMAN**.

Late and Final Registration:

Boys ages 11-14 and girls ages 11 thru 12, can still register and tryout until Friday, March 10, 2017. Boys ages 15-18 can register up to May 15, 2017. BCB Policies:

ALL 11 AND 12-YEAR-OLD BOYS AND 11 AND 12-YEAR-OLD GIRLS WHO ARE NOT ALREADY ON A MAJOR TEAM MUST REGISTER PRIOR TO TRYOUTS ON MARCH 4 or 10, 2017. Those who do not, will be on a waiting list to play in Boardman Community Baseball this season. It is highly suggested that ALL Non-Major players in this age group participate in tryouts. Those who elect <u>NOT</u> to participate in tryouts will be drafted to a Major league team. Those boys and girls who cannot attend the March 4 tryouts must contact their player agent to be excused and arrange to take part in a make-up tryout on Friday, March 10. PLEASE COME EQUIPPED WITH A GLOVE AND BAT TO TRYOUTS, IF POSSIBLE. BATS WILL BE AVAILABLE.

Major Boys & Girls Draft:

BCB OPERATES UNDER ONE LITTLE LEAGUE CHARTER - BCB LITTLE LEAGUE. THE DRAFT SYSTEM FOR THE 2017 SEASON WILL BE A RE-DRAFT OF THE MAJOR/ MINOR AA BOYS AND MAJOR/MINOR GIRLS DIVISIONS. THERE WILL BE 7-8 TEAMS IN ONE DIVISION FOR THE BOYS MAJOR AND 3-5 TEAMS FOR THE GIRLS MAJOR DIVISION. Girl's managers will observe ALL girls trying out. Boy's managers will observe ALL boys trying out. Following tryouts the managers will draft players to their respective team. All drafted players should receive a phone call from the manager within 48 hours of the draft date.

Boys 4 thru 12:

All 4 and 5-yr-old boys will be assigned directly to a Mushball team. Six and most 7-year-old boys will be assigned directly to a Rookie Team. Coaches pitch at the Rookie and Minor A level. Minor A team's players pitch last half of the season. Evaluations will be held for 7 thru 12-year-old boys to insure that the talent level is evenly distributed amongst the teams in each division.

7-yr-old boys have the option of being evaluated and entering the Minor A draft (see below the times by age and division). Any 7-yr-old that is not drafted to a Minor A team will be assigned to a Rookie team.

8-yr-old boys have the option of being evaluated and entering the Minor AA draft (see below the times by age and division). Any 8-yr-old that is not drafted to a Minor AA team will enter the Minor A draft.

10-yr-old boys have the option of being evaluated and entering the Major draft (see below the times by age and division). Any 10-yr-old that is not drafted to a Major team will enter the Minor AA draft.

Any 11-yr-old player not drafted to a Major team will enter the Minor AA draft.

All 12-yr-old players will be drafted to a Major team unless parents make a specific request to play in the Minor AA Division.

Girls 5 thru 14 Fast-Pitch:

All 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8-year-old girls will be assigned directly to a Mushball or Rookie team, Coach pitch. Some 8 and all 9 and 10-year-old girls play Minor league. Player pitch. Tryouts for SOME 8's, ALL 9 and 10-year-olds are being held to better evaluate a player's ability. This will allow us to evenly form teams during the Minor draft. All 11 & 12-year-old girls who PLAYED on a LL Major Team in 2016 MUST participate in tryouts. All who will play as a 7-year-old or younger this year, do not report for tryouts. ONLY 8-YR-OLDS TRYING OUT FOR A MINOR TEAM SHOULD TRYOUT.

Intermediate 50/70 Division:

In 2013 Little League International introduced the Intermediate 50/70 Division after a pilot program in 2012. BCB will participate in a District 2 League with other LL communities to be determined. BCB anticipates 1 team from our League. The age group is 11-13 yr olds with 70-foot bases and 50 foot pitching distance. LL Junior Lg. rules will apply. There will be a separate draft for this League. Players can play both Majors/PONY/JR LL and Intermediate or Intermediate alone, but will be on two different rosters. The focus will be on learning additional aspects of the game (i.e. leadoffs, pickoffs etc.), increased competition and more reps for our players. Bats are 2 5/8 or less. 13-yr-olds will follow PONY pitching rules while 11-12-yr-olds will follow LL pitching rules. There will be additional BCB Pitching Rules incorporated within our league to assure pitchers are not overused. There will be District 2, State, Regional and World Series Tournaments. Players can only play on one All-Star Team. BCB will restrict 13's to the Intermediate team, 12's to the Major team and 11's to the 11-yr-old All-Star team. There will be a 12 game schedule. There is additional \$50 fee for this division with no late fee if you want to register after your other division registration. For more information call TONY PROVENZALE- 565-9343.

Fundraising:

In our continuing effort to raise funds to support our baseball programs and our complex, Boardman Community Baseball needs your help to make our fundraiser a success. Our goal is to raise \$30,000 dollars via our fundraiser. BCB is a private self-supporting operation that receives no financial support from the township, county, state or federal agencies. The main source of income to support our facility and operations is the hosting of tournaments and the annual fundraiser that we ask each player (up to two per family) to participate in. New LL Residency Rule:

In 2014 Little League changed the residency boundary rule regarding where a player lives and the LL League they can play in. Each Little League organization has a boundary map

by which their players must reside to play in said league. Now if a student attends a school that is within the league's boundary that player can play in said league regardless of their community residence. Proof of attendance is required from the school's administration.

Chuck Schafer Memorial Scholarship Tournament:

The 14th Chuck Schafer Memorial Scholarship Tournament will be held June 30-July 2, 2017. The tournament raises funds for the Chuck Schafer Scholarship and Boardman Community Baseball.
