- 1. Teams cannot register at the tournament. All teams <u>must</u> sanction prior to arrival. All information must be submitted 7 days before start of tournament.
- 2. The Tournament Director reserves the right to change the tournament format at any time due to weather or any unforeseen circumstances. No rain date is planned.
- 3. The tournament fee for this four (4) game format tournament is \$350.00 (U.S.). Planned format is four games with all teams advancing to a single elimination tournament. All teams may have to play Friday night; however we will give special consideration to out of area teams when possible.
- 4. All teams must be sanctioned by ASA and present proof of insurance prior to play. Contact ASA's Cal Cavalcante at (330) 856-7010 or by e-mail at calccavalcante@aol.com for information. All teams must check in to have these items verified at the Fields of Dreams Complex before the team's first game.
- 5. In case of rain, managers are responsible for contacting the Tournament Director to confirm game times and any additional rescheduling information.
- 6. Berths to the ASA Eastern National Qualifier will be awarded in each age bracket per the ASA guidelines.
- 7. Team trophies and individual awards will be given to the 1st and 2nd place teams in each age bracket.
- 8. ASA Rules will govern all play. Tie breakers for seeding to the Single Elimination Bracket of the tournament are (in order): Win-Loss Record, Head to Head Results; Run Differential; and then Coin Toss.
- 9. A coin toss will determine the home team for each game and the home team will be responsible for keeping the official scorebook.
- 10. Scheduled game time is forfeit time (NO GRACE PERIOD). All teams must be at the field and prepared to play 20 minutes before scheduled game time.
- 11. All games except for the Championships will be 7 innings or 80 minute time limit. If the score is tied after 7 innings or 80 minutes, the Ohio ASA International tiebreaker rules will determine the winner. An inning that begins before the expiration of the time limit will be completed regardless of the score of either team. (For Championships, if home team is ahead, inning does not need to be completed).
- 12. A mercy rule will apply to all games as outlined by the Ohio ASA. Coaches are responsible for knowing the team's schedule and being aware of any changes.
- 13. There will be a \$75.00 "rules" protest fee, due, payable in <u>cash</u>, at the time of the protest. The fee will be refunded to the protesting team if the protest is ruled in their favor. No protests will be allowed for judgment calls.
- 14. A \$3.00 daily entrance fee will be charged on Friday, Saturday and Sunday per person. Twelve (12) and under are free. Three (3) coaches passes will be provided.
- 15. Boardman Community Baseball Inc., the ASA and Ohio ASA will not be held responsible for any accident or injury during this tournament.
- All parents, fans, and players are to OBEY any parking regulations posted or instructions given or they will be subject to having their vehicle towed. BCB FIELD OF DREAMS DOES NOT PERMIT PETS, GRILLS, RV'S, PRIVATE GOLF CARTS, ALCOHOL OR FIREARMS AT THE COMPLEX.
- 17. No warm-ups allowed on playing fields. Hitting balls against backstops and fences is not permitted. Pitchers must warm-up in bullpens and on warning tracks on fields S-1 and S-2.
- 18. Concessions will be available. Seating around diamonds is limited, bring chairs.
- 19. WEATHER AND ITS EFFECT ON THE FIELDS IS BEYOND THE CONTROL OF THE ASA & THE TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE. NO RAIN DATE.
- 20. Face masks are required and only ASA-approved bats will be allowed.
